BKL to continue its expansion strategy.

The new organisational structure reflects BKL's successful development as one of Europe's leading providers of crane solutions. In the last three years alone, the company has increased its turnover in the three segments of crane rental, sales and service by almost 30 percent to roughly 83 million euros. Today, its crane fleet comprises in excess of 500 tower cranes, over 100 mobile cranes and more than 20 mobile construction cranes, plus numerous loader cranes and a wide range of transport equipment. At present, 333 employees at seven locations ensure that well over 10,000 operations per year are carried out professionally for customers all over Germany and Europe.

As one of the first steps in implementing its 2023 expansion plan, the crane specialist launched BKL Aschaffenburg in March. The additional site expands the full services for construction and mobile cranes provided by BKL Center/West for the Rhine/Main region.

The next changes will extend the services BKL offers throughout Germany and enhance BKL's operational performance still further at the regional level, but also on the international stage.
