BKL wins the innovation competition and was officially nominated as one of the Top 100 on 19 June.

Munich, 13 July 2020 – As of 19 June, BKL Baukran Logistik GmbH is officially a Top 100 SME in Germany and thus represents the performance elite in this class. The crane expert came out on top throughout the scientific selection process, especially in the category "Innovative Processes/Organization". In fact, the crane rental and service provider made the Top 10 in this category, despite competition being particularly intense this year, according to the event organizer. The award highlights BKL's aspiration to be an industry pioneer.
